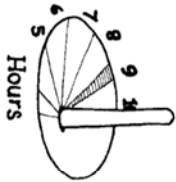
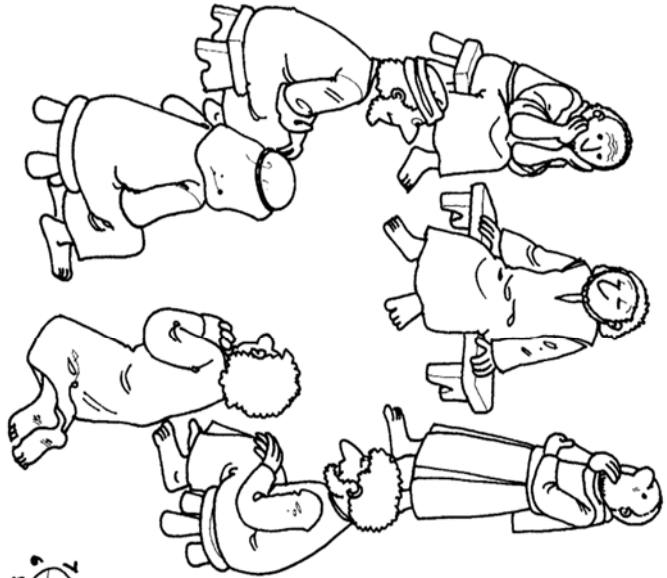
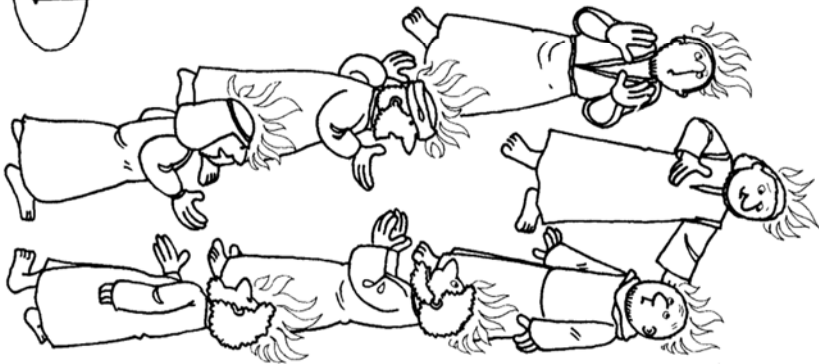

THEY WANTED THE PRESENCE OF THE REAL GOD MORE THAN ANYTHING ELSE. DO YOU?

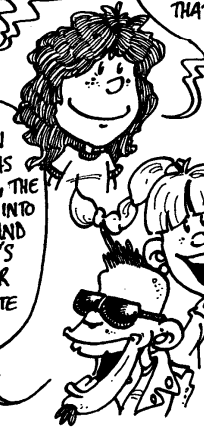
THEY MADE THEMSELVES AVAILABLE TO GOD. WHAT ABOUT YOU?

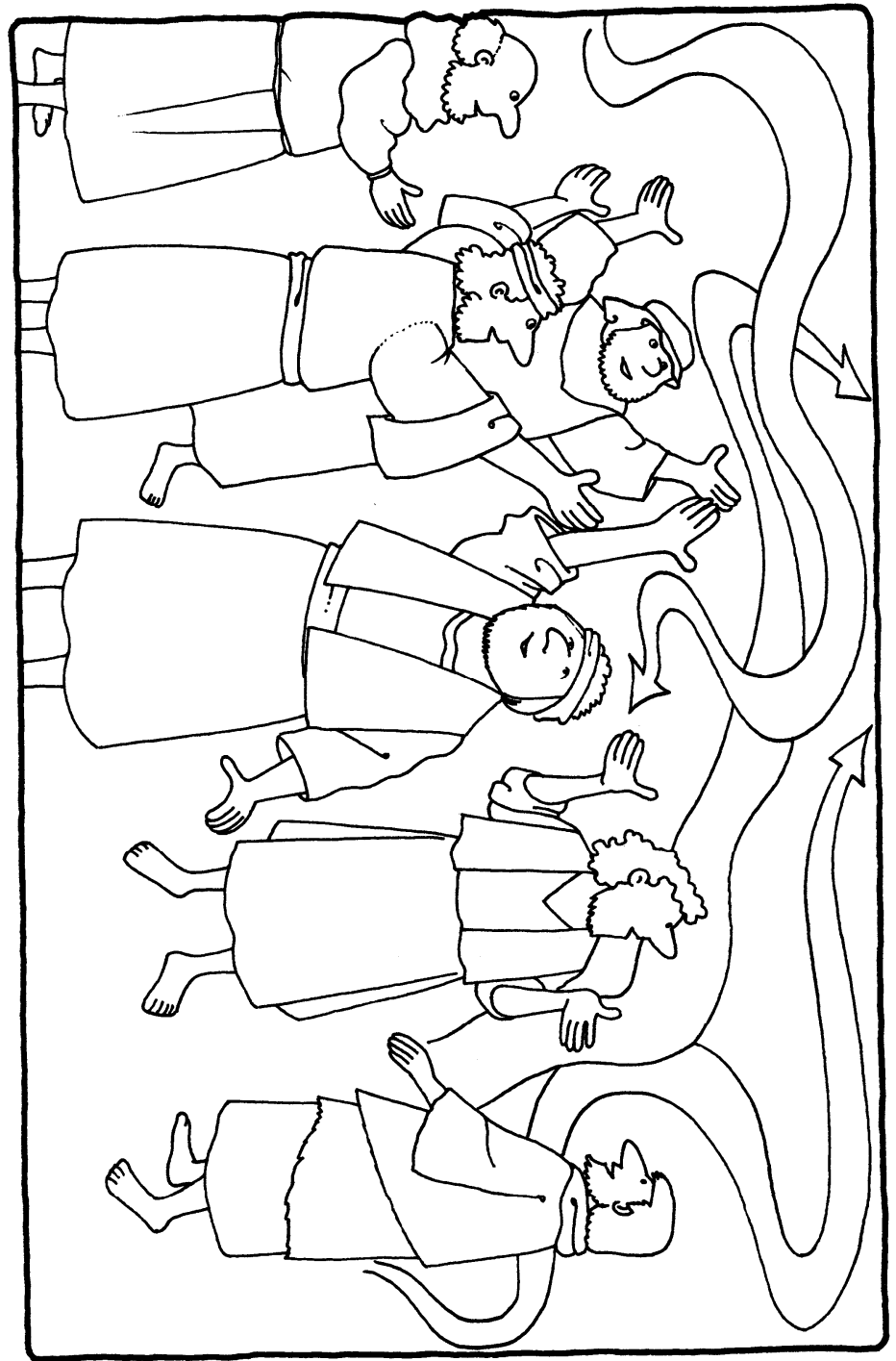
THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD

CAN IT COME TO ANYONE? Yes, to anyone who is open to God and expectant, wanting to receive his life and power.

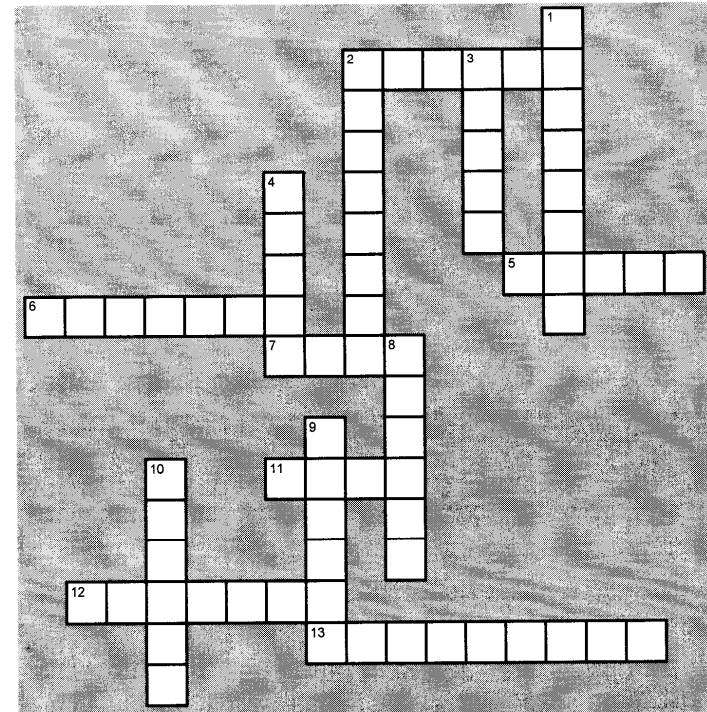
DOESN'T IT KNOCK YOU OVER? Sometimes! But the Spirit can also come with great gentleness. God loves you. He knows the best way for you.
