### Matthew 13:23

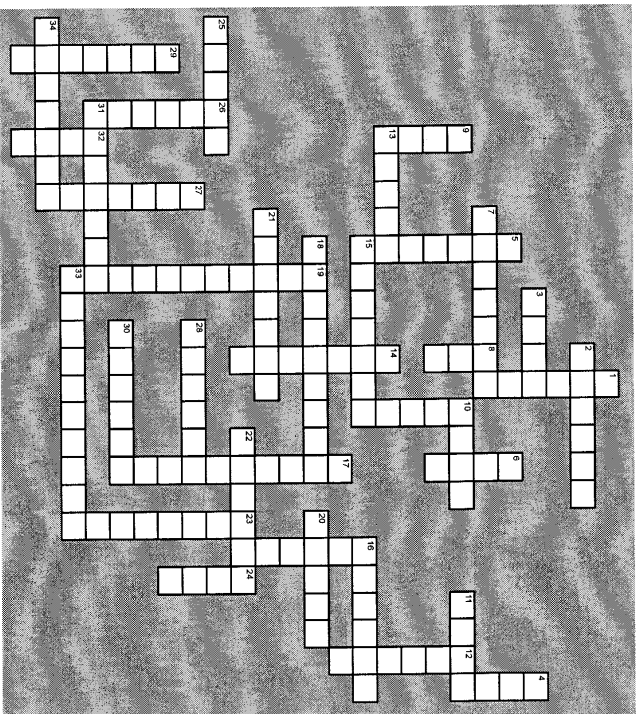
The seed that fell on good soil is the man who hears the word and understands it. He produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown.

In Jesus' name we pray. **Amen**

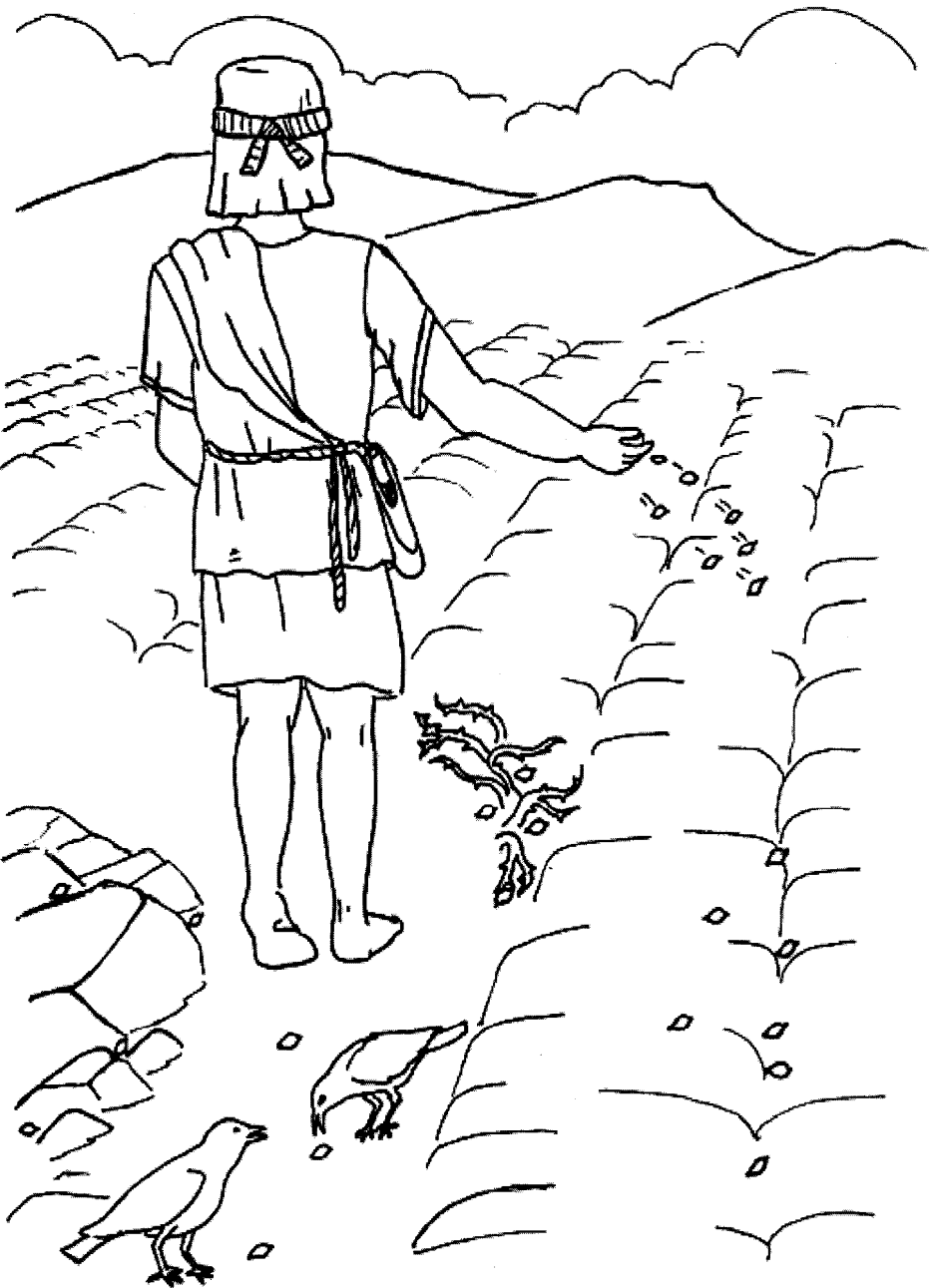

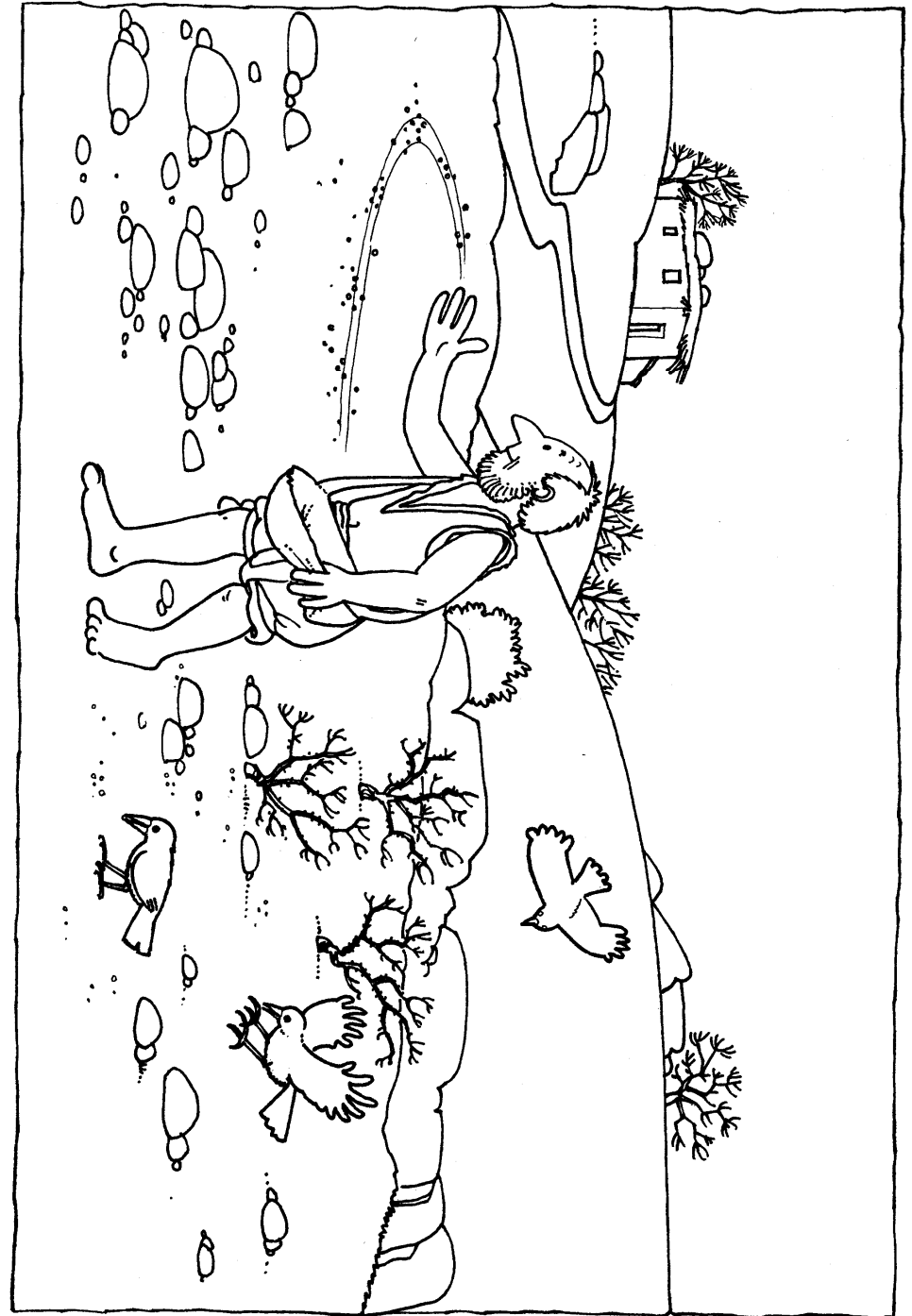

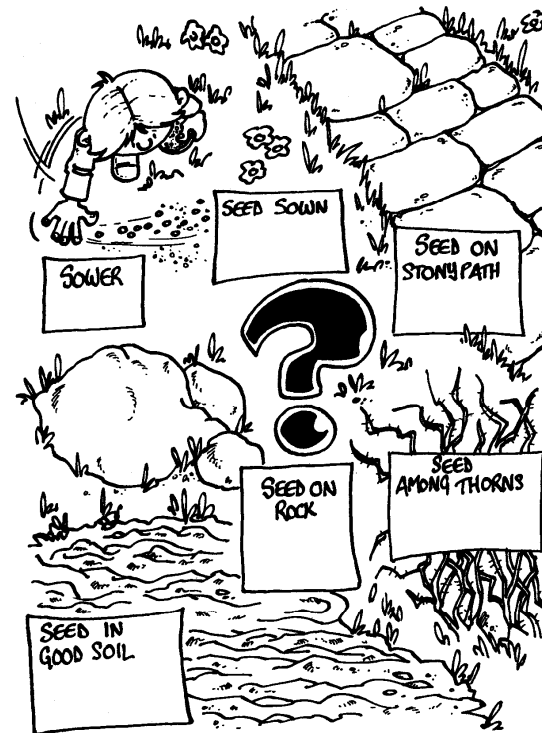
