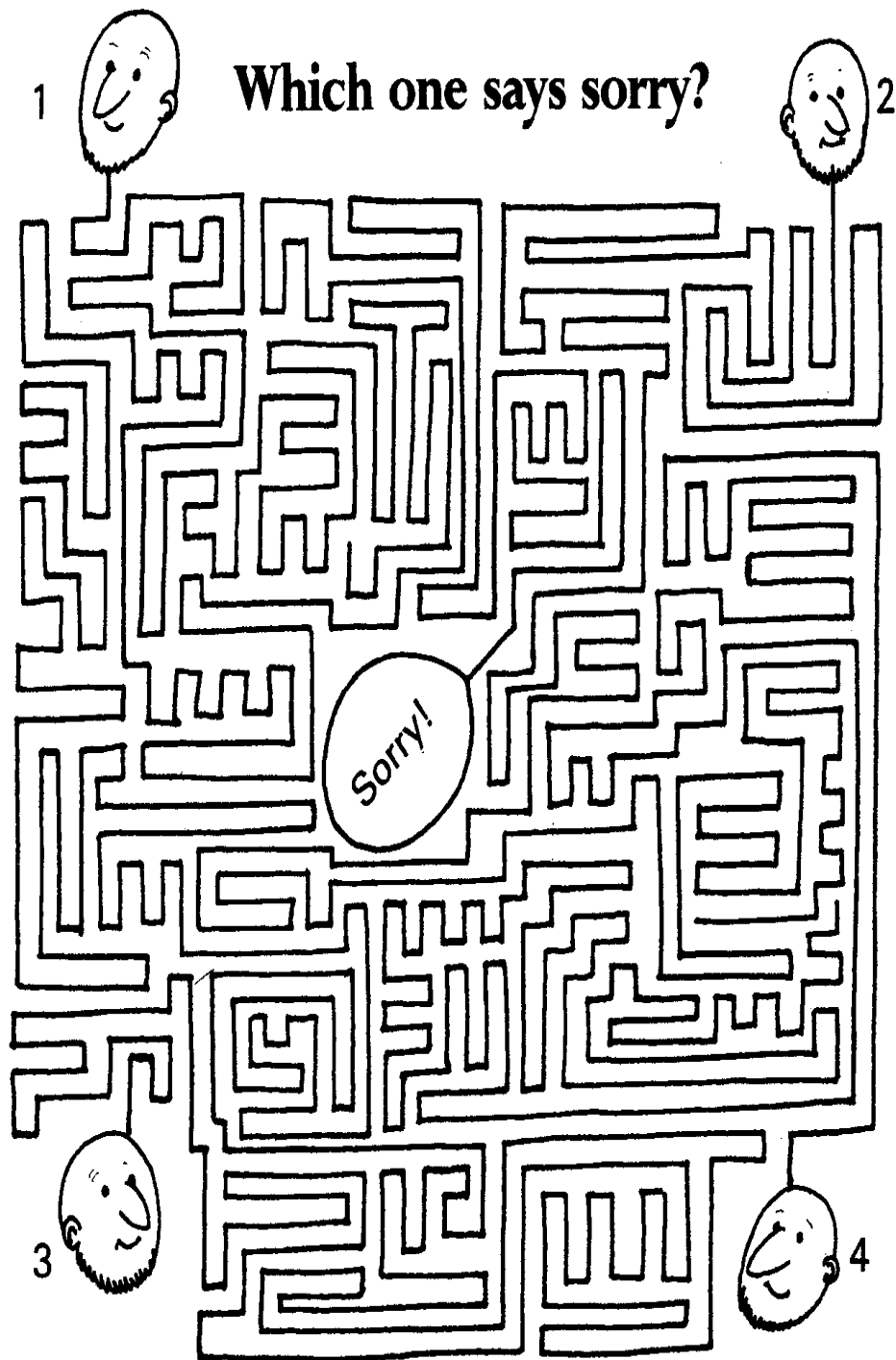

WHAT IS FORGIVING?

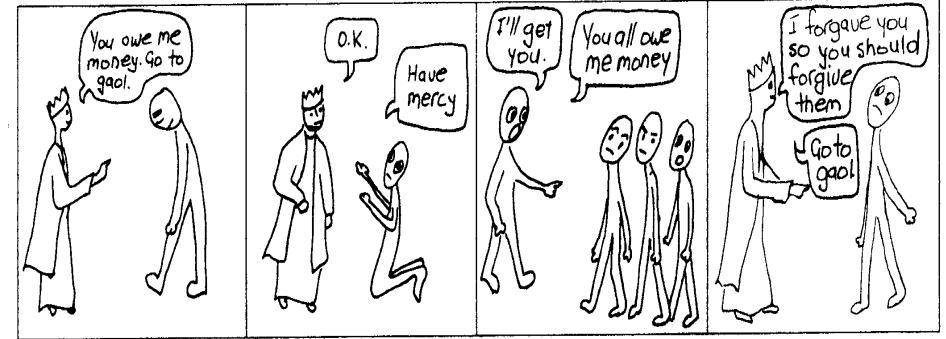
Forgiving is cancelling a debt. If someone has wronged you it's as if they are in debt to you. When you forgive them you let them off.

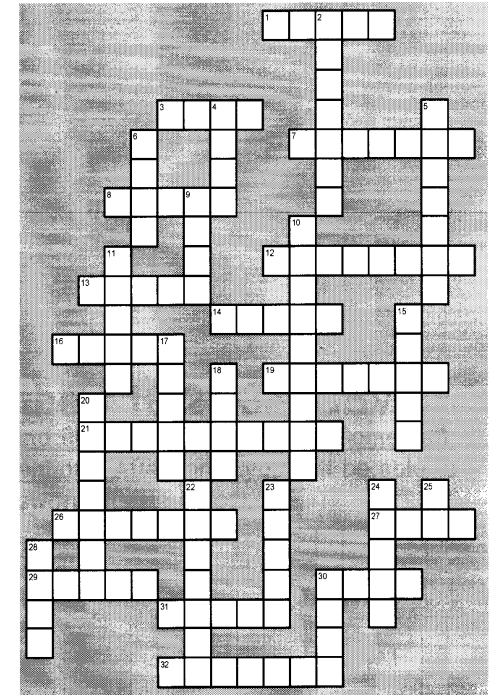
