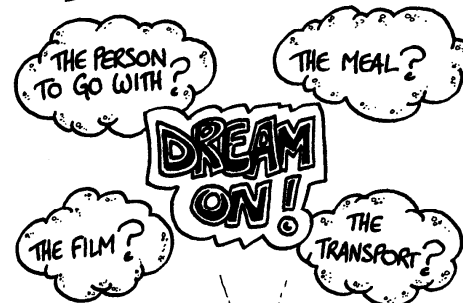
CHOICES
