MESSIAH IS COMING!
WHAT DOES 'MESSIAH' MEAN?
It means God's anointed one, chosen and set apart to save the people.
WHAT LANGUAGE IS IT?
Hebrew. The Greek word for Messiah is 'Christ'.
HOW DID THE PEOPLE KNOW THE MESSIAH WOULD COME?
The prophets spoke out what God wanted to say, and they kept telling the hope of this promised Messiah.
